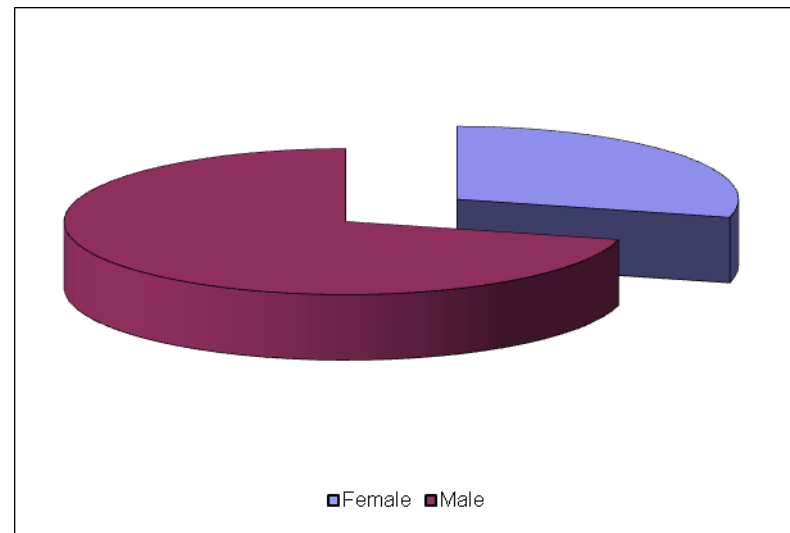

- 71% Male

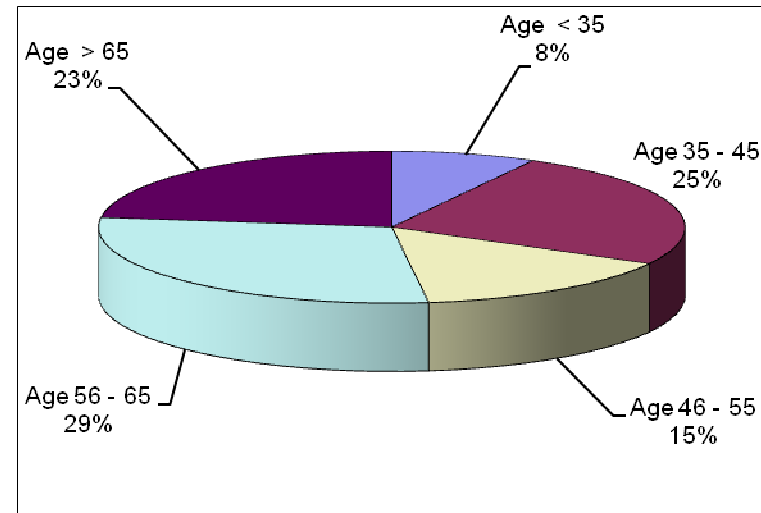

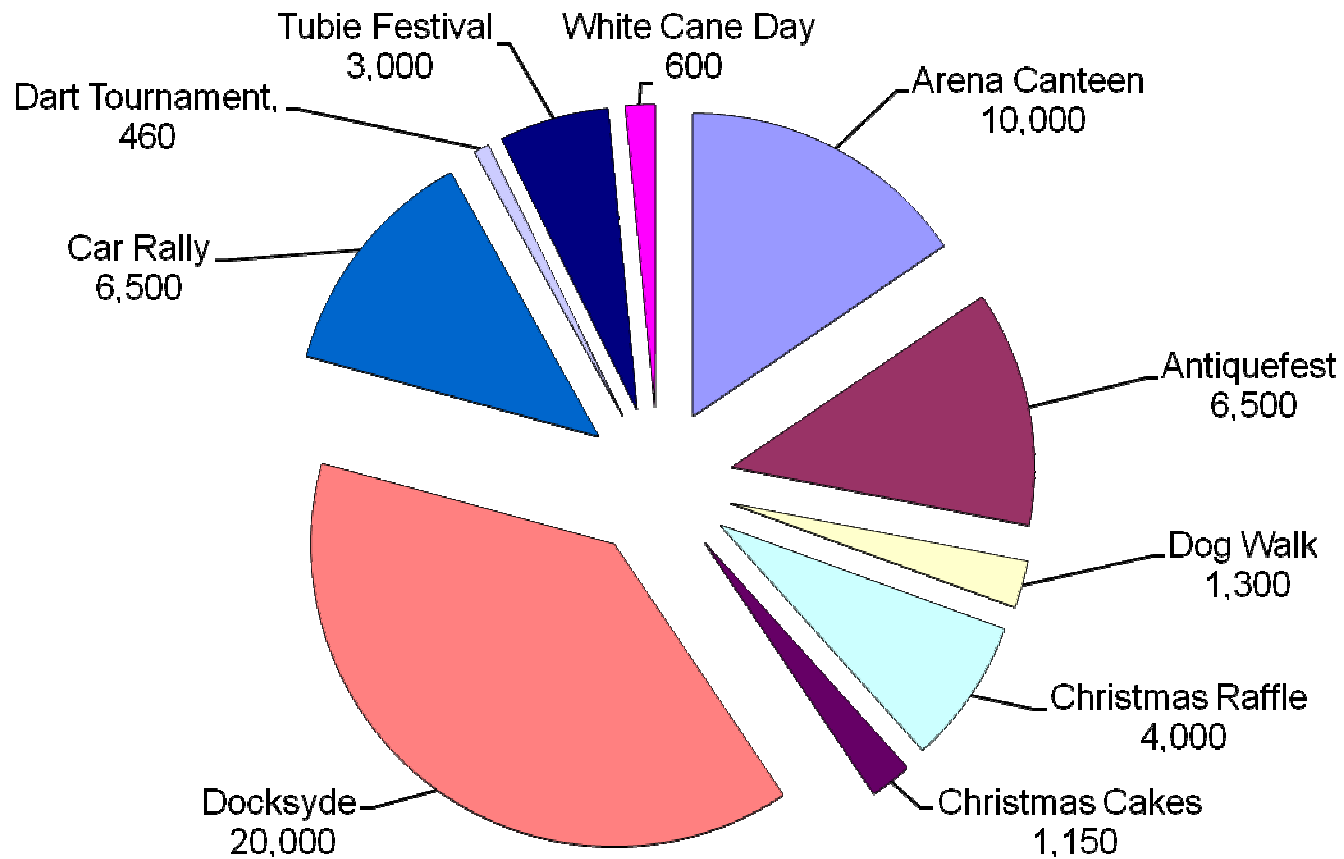
Membership Profile: Age

- 23% > 65 years of age



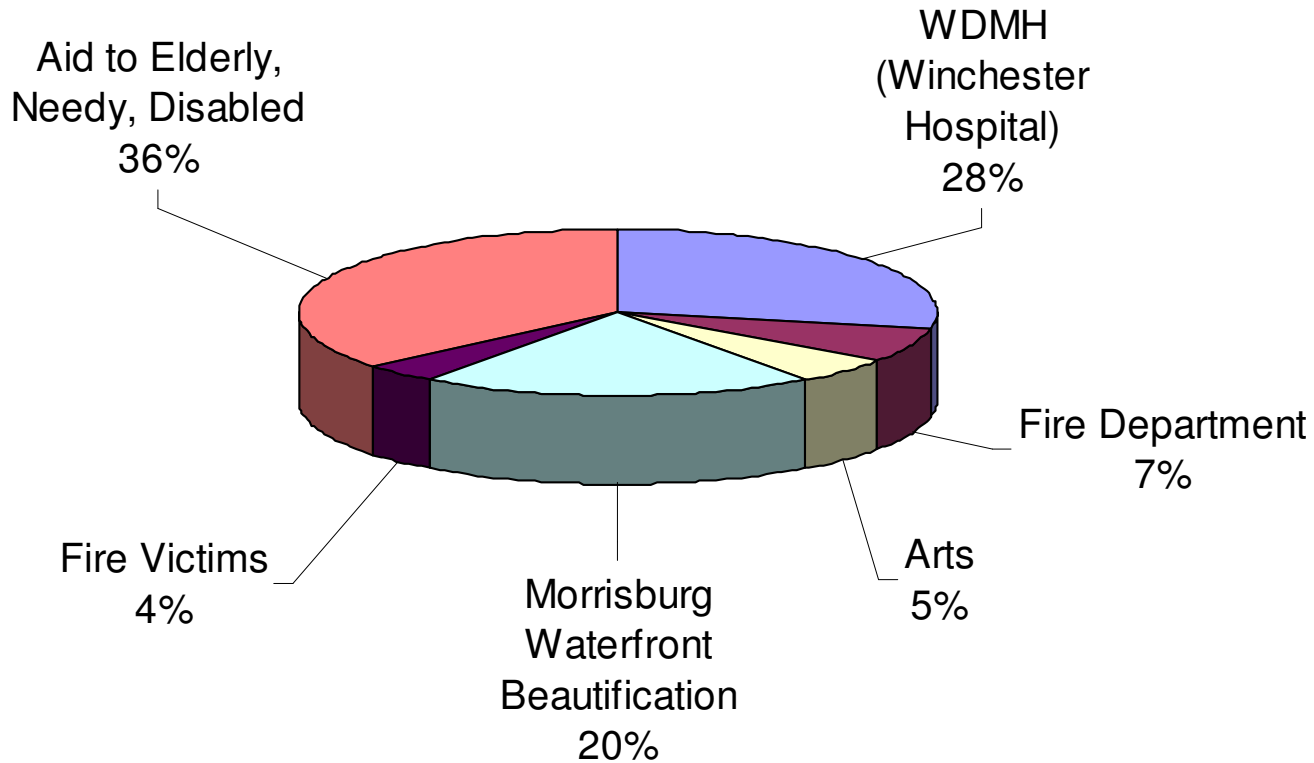


Revenue



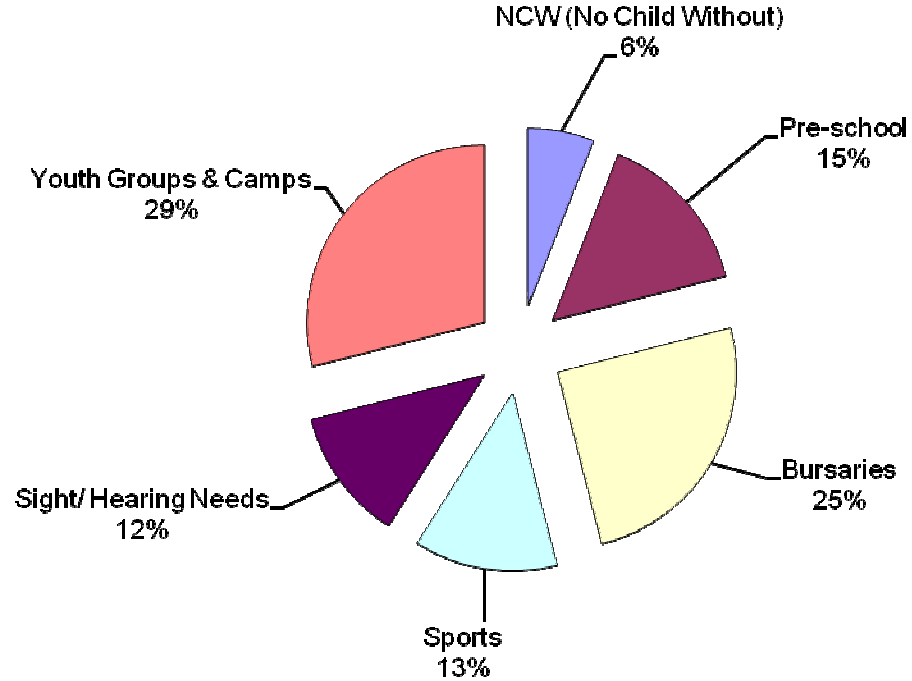


Donations: Community Services (\$23,000)
